

## Meeting

*The meeting of Governing Body of Nimapara (Auto) College was held Under the Chairmanship of Sj. Jagat Prasad Sabut, President G.B. and unanimously decided the following.*

The Proceedings of the previous meeting dated 14.02.2022 was read out by the Principal -Cum- Secretary G.B ,Sj. Ramakanta Dash and the same was confirmed.

- Principal Sri. Dash welcomed all the members, Hon'ble President G.B and Special Invitee Hon'ble Minister School & Mass Education, Sri Samir Ranjan Dash and requested all to extend their cooperation for the all-round development of the Institution.
- The income and expenditure of the college 1.10.2019- 31.03.2020 & 01.04.2021 to 31.03.2022 was discussed and approved. Income-Expenditure statement is attached to the proposal.
- Sj. S.R Dash, Hon'ble Minister School & Mass Education, Prof. J.P Sabut President G.B & members of G.B Prof. J.C Mishra, Prof. L.D Panda , Prof. Sabita Harichandan, Regional Director gave their valuable suggestions on academic and administrative reforms and considering the proposals. It was unanimously decided to take the following measures with immediate effect.
- As per the resolution taken in G.B meeting it was informed that the college has included seminar periods in the routine and in this regard another step was added i.e. to felicitate the best paper presenter.
- It was decided to allow 4cr. Of land to Higher Secondary Education. Principal was advised to take steps for correction of ROR accordingly.
- Prof. J. Mishra suggested for publication of college magazine as soon as possible and Principal was requested to do the same.
- Hon'ble members discussed about the progress in the construction of Auditorium was discussed and Hon'ble minster declared to contribute an amount of 50 lakhs from his MLA LAD fund.
- College budget for 2022-23, presented by Sj. Chandramani Sahoo, Accounts Bursar, was discussed vividly and got the approval of the body.
- The UC out of 43 lakhs received as FANI grant 28 lakhs and Infrastructure development grant 15 lakhs, the utilization certificate of 38 lakhs submitted to Govt. is approved.



- The proposal for opening of study centre by Odisha state Open University was discussed and approved.
- Opening of professional course in PPP mode in collaboration with Heritage Vision Education Trust was discussed. It was decided to start the same from academic session 2022-23 with the approval of Government.
  - ↓ 3 years Bachelor Course of Business Administration in Banking & Finance (BBABF)(64 seats).
  - ↓ 3 years Bachelor Course of Computer Application (BCA)(64 seats).
  - ↓ 2 Master in Commerce in Finance & Control (MFC)(32 seats).
  - ↓ Master of Arts in Journalism & Mass Communication (MAJMC) (32 seats).
- Proposal of opening of P.G in Pol.Sc & Physics was submitted before the body & in this connection cooperation from Hon'ble Minister was sought for opening of the same.
- Members expressed satisfaction over the progress of World Bank Project. Further negotiation with R&B for the construction of the Auditorium was intimated to the members.
- Proposal for purchase of land in any direction for the extension of college campus was approved. Authorization in this connection was given to Principal.
- 75% of attendance for students has been made mandatory by Govt. of Odisha and it was decided to serve notice in this connection.
- Proposal for recovery of EPF contribution from staff members shifted from Block Grant to GIA fold was resolved.
- Considering the recommendation of Board of Studies initiation for introduction of ADD-On courses for students from the current Academic Session was discussed and approved.
- Proposal for upgradation of Museum and preservation of Manuscripts to be taken up with issuing letters to the Department of Culture.
- Principal presented a PPT on different activities held during the session 2021-22 and placed the action plan for the next session.
- The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
