ANALYSIS REPORT OF STUDENT FEEDBACK

NIMAPARA AUTONOMOUS COLLEGE, NIMAPARA, PURI

A separate questionnaire was distributed to the students in Google format through their respective HODs. The questions contain issues relating to fairness and transparency in the admission process, teaching learning process, examination pattern as well as facilities regarding library, laboratory, toilet, drinking water, quality of course content etc.

Majority of the students have mentioned that at the beginning of the session, teachers discussed syllabi of the semester and covered the portion accordingly. The teaching and learning process according to the students was effective and teacher's approach to teaching was very good. Students also mentioned that teacher' discussed examination patterns very often and prepared them for the examination by providing every possible help.

Internal examination was conducted very fairly and the evaluation process was very fair. They also mentioned that the teachers identified their strength and weakness and help them to overcome their shortcoming. Majority of students also said that the Institution always encourages them to participate in extra-curricular activities. They mentioned that the conduct of Soprts and Games are very good. Most of the students express their opinion that the college should improve their soft skill and open opportunities for career development.

Further they mentioned that ICT facilities inside the campus should be improved. Regarding laboratory facilities, many of the students said that it was Satisfactory. However students express their opinion that library, toilet and drinking water facilities needs to be improved.
